Step 1: https://stanfordhealthcare.cloud-cme.com

Step 2: Click "Sign In" at the upper left side of the screen.



Step 3: You will be directed to the User Login Screen. Click the gray button "SHC EMPLOYEES ONLY". If you are already signed into the SHC network with your SID, you will automatically be logged in.
