

Basic Life Support (BLS)

BLS is geared towards prehospital providers, like EMTs, paramedics, fire fighters, and in-facility hospital providers. Upon successful completion of the course, students receive a course completion card, valid for two years.

BLS Training Options:

BLS is available in two different training methods – blended learning and classroom training. All BLS course options teach the same AHA science-based skills and result in the same AHA BLS Course Completion eCard. All our courses are offered as a package and include everything you need to complete the course from start to finish.

Course Types:

- Classroom – Instructor-led, hands-on class format: BLS provider
- Blended Learning – Online with skills check: BLS heartcode + skills check

BLS Initial Certification & Renewals

BLS provider and BLS heartcode + skills check courses can be taken for certification renewals and first-time certifications. We recommend you attend the BLS provider course if it is your first-time getting certified or have not renewed your certification in several years.
